# BLACK FRIDAY SAFETY

Here are a few quick tips from the Winter Springs Police Department if you are out shopping all the big deals this holiday season.

- 1. Stay alert and be aware of what's going on around you.
- 2. Park in a well-lit space, be sure to lock the car, close the windows, and hide shopping bags and gifts in the trunk.

- 3. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash: pay with a debit or credit card where ever possible.
- 4. Deter pickpockets and purse-snatchers.
  - · Don't overburden yourself with packages.
  - · Be careful with purses and wallets.
  - Carry a purse close to your body, not dangling by the straps.
  - Put a wallet in an inside coat or front pants pocket.
- 5. Teach your children to go to a store clerk or security if you get separated.

You're required under the law to pick up your pet's waste on private property (unless consent is given by the owner) and public property (sidewalks, recreation areas, etc.).*
- 2. Good for Wildlife: It's a great relief to wildlife, keeping your dog from chasing squirrels, deer, and other wildlife.
- 3. It's the Law: It is the law in Seminole County! The law is in place to protect other members of the public and your pet from injury.

Many businesses and individuals discard wastewater, pollution, and debris onto the ground and into the storm drains that may cause lake pollution. A storm drain is part of the stormwater system that collects rainwater from streets, parking lots and rooftops. In most cases, polluted stormwater runoff drains directly into one of our lakes through the underground storm sewer system.
