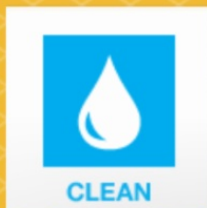

Four Steps to Food Safety:

STAY HEALTHY IN 2021

Follow these four steps from the CDC to protect yourself from food poisoning!

1. **Clean** - Wash your hands and surfaces often! Always wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water before, during, and after preparing food.
2. **Separate** - Don't cross-contaminate! Use a separate cutting board for raw meats and keep them separate from other foods.
3. **Cook** - Always check the internal temperature! Use a food thermometer to ensure it is safely cooked.
4. **Chill** - Keep your refrigerator at or below 40°F! Thaw frozen food safely in the refrigerator, never that foods on the counter!
