#### STAY HEALTHY IN 2021

Remember the basics of keeping yourself and others healthy this year!

The CDC recommends that people wear masks in public settings, like on public and mass transportation, at events and gatherings, and anywhere they will be around other people to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

#### Here are some helpful mask tips:

- Wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth and secures under your chin.
- Masks should fit snugly against the sides of your face.
- When removing a mask, handle only by the ear loops or ties and be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing.
- Wash your hands immediately before putting on your mask and immediately after removing it.
- Keep a spare mask to replace one that may become wet from breath or rain.
- If you have to continually adjust your mask, it doesn't fit properly, consider finding a
  different mask type or brand.
