STAY HEALTHY IN 2021

Remember the basics of keeping yourself and others healthy this year!

1. Wash your hands often

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after being in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

2. Avoid close contact

Put 6 feet of distance between yourself and people who don't live in your household. Remember that some people without symptoms may be able to spread the virus. Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people. Keeping distance from others is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

3. Cover your mouth and nose with a mask when around others

You could spread COVID-19 to others even if you do not feel sick. The mask is meant to protect other people in case you are infected. Everyone should wear a mask in public settings and when around people who don't live in your household, especially when other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.
