Meet our Winter Springs City Staff! Samantha Jakubcin, Jason French, and Garyl Gibson are three of our dedicated meter readers. The meter readers are essential employees to the City who manually read each commercial and residential meter. Without these reads, it would be impossible to bill customers for water consumption used each month accurately. They usually walk several miles on the days they read meters to get the reads required in their designated area. They are often found cleaning out meter boxes to ensure suitable reading conditions for the next day. They also work hard to repair and replace broken meter boxes and meter box lids. They work together to replace old and hard-to-read meters and help the utility department identify meter leaks needing repair. Next time you see them around in your neighborhood, wave hello!
