WINTER SPRINGS RANKED ONE OF **THE BEST SMALL CITIES IN AMERICA**



Winter Springs is rated as one of the "2021 Best Small Cities in America" by Wallethub.Com. In a comparisonbetween 1,300 U.S Cities

with populations between 25,000 and 100,000, Winter Springs scored in the top rankings. Wallet hub measures 43 key factors of livability and five key dimensions. These dimensions include affordability, economic health, education, quality of life, and safety. All these factors are weighted to calculate an overall score using data collected by the U.S census, FBI, Medicare and Medicaid, Bureau of labor statistics, and other credible sources.

Niche.com ranks Winter Springs 6th in the top 25 suburbs to buy a house in the Greater Orlando area. Niche gave Winter Springs an "A" in public schools, good for families, and diversity categories. Overall report card grade was an "A+". Winter Springs was also rated 25 out of 380 for Best Public Schools in Florida. JULY SAFETY TIP BLOG: FIREWORK SAFETY

If consumer fireworks are legal to buy where you live and you choose to use them, be sure to follow the following safety tips:

Never allow young children to handle fireworks

Older children should use them only under close adult supervision

Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol

Only use them away from people, houses and flammable material

Never point or throw fireworks at another person

Only light one device at a time and maintain a safe distance after lighting

Soak both spent and unused fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding

Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish fireworks that don't go off or in case of fire

Never use illegal fireworks

Better yet, grab a blanket and a patch of lawn, kick back and let the experts handle the fireworks show.


SENIOR CENTER
