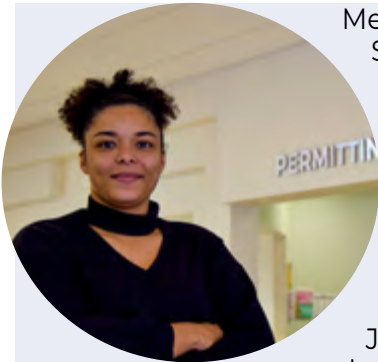




EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT

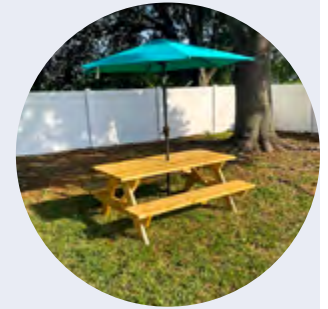
When not at work, Jade loves spending time with her family and woodworking, which she learned from her father.
