CREEK CLEAN UP

Beginning in early August, contractors for the City of Winter Springs will begin clearing debris from several creeks. The City has selected "Looks Great Services" to complete the work. "Looks Great Services" specializes in waterway cleanup, vegetative removal, and disaster recovery. Contractors will prioritize the areas that were hit hardest by the 2022 hurricane season. Creeks such as No Name, Bear, Gee, Howell, and Sheoah are areas the crews will focus on. Cleaning the creeks and waterways will allow water to flow more steadily, limiting and controlling flooding. 
SENIOR CENTER
