TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE FOR VETERANS IN SEMINOLE COUNTY

Heart of Florida United Way is thrilled to introduce the Mission United Lyft Rideshare Program, providing transportation assistance to Veterans in Seminole county. This program enables local Veterans to access essential resources in their everyday lives, including medical appointments, legal consultations, job interviews, and grocery shopping.

To be eligible, Veterans must be 18 years or older and reside in Seminole County. They need to have the Lyft App, a current Lyft account, and a valid payment option linked to their account. The Rideshare Intake Form, along with all required documentation, must be submitted at least two business days prior to the needed ride.

To request a ride, Veterans or their caretakers should contact the program at least two business days in advance. Upon submitting a ride request, the Mission United staff will provide a unique code to the approved Veteran within one hour. Each scheduled ride covers up to \$25 for a one-way trip (or a maximum of two \$25 rideshare codes for a round-trip). Veterans are responsible for any costs exceeding the \$25 limit.
