## CONSERVE WATER: DAYLIGHT SAVINGS WATERING RESTIRCTIONS

The following lawn watering rules began Sunday, March 12, 2023, and will remain in effect until Sunday, November 5, 2023.

- No lawn watering between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm on any day.
- Even-numbered addresses are allowed to water on Thursdays and Sundays.
- Odd-numbered addresses or non-residences (businesses, HOAs, etc.) are allowed to water on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- Water for no more than one hour per zone.

These rules apply if you use potable water or a private well for irrigation. If you have reclaimed water for irrigation, then you may water two days per week year-round. Always water when needed. When you conserve water, you save money and help our environment!

WHEN CAN I WATER MY LAWN?

#### **STORMWATER POLLUTION**

- Do not wash debris or pollution down the storm drains. This can contribute to blockages that increase the chance of flooding , and can also release damaging chemicals and organic material into our lakes.
- Do not alter the normal function of stormwater system elements. Stormwater is designed to flow a certain way, so changes to the flow of water in one place can adversely affect another area.

#### CERTIFICATE OF SAFETY RECOGNITION AWARDED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Winter Springs Police Department received a Certificate of Safety Excellence(CSE) from the Florida League of Cities on February 14, 2023. This distinction is awarded to law enforcement agencies that meet the highest safety management standards. Documentation protocol, emergency readiness, staff training, firearm safety, and communication are some areas evaluated to receive the CSE. Our department received an overall score of 90%, among the highest in the county. Winter Springs Police Department remains dedicated to ensuring the safety of our officers, staff, and community.

### APRIL SAFETY BLOG: DISTRACTED DRIVING AWARENESS

Distracted driving is any activity that diverts the attention from driving. This includes talking to passengers, texting on your phone, eating, drinking, and manipulating the stereo or navigation system. Simply put, it is anything that takes your attention away from the task of safe driving.

Texting is the most alarming distraction. Sending or reading a text takes your eyes off the road for approximately 5 seconds. At 55 mph, that's like driving the length of an entire football field with your eyes closed.

You cannot drive safely unless the task of driving has your full attention. Any non-driving activity you engage in is a potential distraction and increases your risk for a crash.


