City of Winter Springs releases Annual Drinking Water Quality Reports for 2022

WINTER SPRINGS, Fla.- The City of Winter Springs announces its <u>Annual Drinking Water Quality Reports for</u> <u>2022</u> are now available.

The reports, which cover the period of January 1 to December 31, 2022, found that the City of Winter Springs drinking water meets or exceeds all Federal and State water quality regulations.

The City of Winter Springs water comes from the Floridan aquifer via eight groundwater wells.

These are then treated at one of our three water treatment plants and delivered through approximately 244 miles of pipeline to about 14,120 connections.

The City routinely monitors its drinking water for contaminants per all Federal and State rules, regulations, and laws to ensure safe and clean water for our customers.

Our groundwater is a clean, affordable source of drinking water, but it is not an inexhaustible resource.

As part of our commitment to preserving our natural resources while better serving the community we have implemented a Water Conservation Program.

The program seeks to promote water conservation and reduce water consumption among City residents through education, incentive programs, free services such as irrigation audits, and more.
