Winter Springs residents asked to limit reclaimed water usage as demand increases.

WINTER SPRINGS, Fla.--Due to limited rainfall and increased demand, Winter Springs residents are encouraged to reduce their use of reclaimed water.

The request comes as the City of Winter Springs Utilities works to meet current irrigation needs and maintain adequate system pressure for all customers.

Over the past several weeks high demand has significantly reduced the operational supply of reclaimed water in storage.

By limiting use and following watering restriction ordinances, residents can reduce demand and allow the system to restore to normal operating levels.
