## Precautionary boil water advisory issued for Highlands area residents

**WINTER SPRINGS, Fla.**— Residents in the area of Sheoah Boulevard in the Highlands area are advised of a water outage and precautionary boil water advisory due to a water main break in the vicinity.

On July 31, 2023 a private contractor installing fiber optic lines for WOW Fiber Internet Services hit a 12 inch water main near the intersection of Sheoah Boulevard and Clean Court.

While working to repair the water line and restore service to the area City of Winter Springs Utilities crews were forced to shut down a larger portion of the service area and expand the number of homes as part of the boil water notice.

The precautionary boil water notice has been expanded to include 425 homes along Sheoah Boulevard south to 3rd Street.

Residents should follow these precautions until further notice:

1. Boil water intended for consumption: It is recommended to bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute before using it for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or any other activity that involves consuming water.
2. Use boiled or bottled water: Please use boiled water or commercially bottled water for all food preparation, including washing fruits and vegetables, and making beverages such as coffee and tea.

The notice will be lifted once laboratory testing shows negative results for any biological contamination within a 48 hour period.
