City of Winter Springs proclaims April as Water Conservation Month

WINTER SPRINGS, Fla. – On March 20, 2024, Winter Springs Mayor Kevin McCann proclaimed the month of April as Water Conservation Month in the City of Winter Springs.

Water Conservation Month is observed throughout the State of Florida every April which is typically a dry month and when water demands are most high.

It is estimated around 3 billion gallons of water are used every day in Central Florida by more than 9 million residents and visitors. Future water demands are projected to increase to approximately 4.1 billion gallons per day by 2040. One of the most effective ways to address increasing water needs is through water conservation.

The City of Winter Springs has long encouraged water conservation through various educational programs and has long encouraged businesses, schools, and citizens to make a difference by conserving water.


WHEREAS, water is a basic and essential need of every living creature; and

WHEREAS, every business, industry, school, and citizen can make a difference by conserving water and thus promoting a healthy economy and community; and


NOW THEREFORE, I, Kevin McCann, Mayor of the City of Winter Springs, Florida do hereby Proclaim the month of April as:
