Winter Springs creek sediment removal project to begin April 8, 2024

WINTER SPRINGS, Fla.-- Starting Monday April 8, 2024, crews contracted with the City of Winter Springs will begin the process of removing sediment from several waterways within the City.

Thanks to a grant from the Natural Resources Conservation Services (NRCS), Zulu Marine Services of Columbia, Mississippi, will begin the essential task of clearing sediment from around four separate creek crossings to restore functionality and improve the smooth flow of storm water throughout the City.

Under the terms of the grant, the NRCS will contribute up to 75% of the project's total cost, with the City covering the remaining 25%.

The project, approved by the City Commission February 26, 2024 will start with work along Gee Creek, and is expected to take several weeks to complete.
