### Please join us for our 9<sup>th</sup> annual Cops for Kids House charity Kickball tournament!

Kid's House of Seminole is a non-profit organization which aids in the investigation and treatment of child abuse victims. Law enforcement agencies from all of Seminole County and including bordering jurisdictions such as Winter Park and

- Computer reporting and dispatch
- Applicable Laws
- General Orders and Procedures

Flexible Schedules are available and only a minimum of 12 hours per month is required. All necessary equipment and uniforms will be provided.
