Dear Neighbors,

As Floridians, we know that the month of June marks the start of Hurricane Season. While you and your family are preparing, the City is also taking our annual precautions to ensure hurricane preparedness through planning and conversing with Duke Energy, Seminole County, and other municipalities as well as promoting readiness to residents across the County.

At our Monday, May 14, City Commission meeting a Duke Energy representative spoke and presented their team's Hurricane Preparedness Efforts for 2018. We were able to listen and comment on the steps they are taking to ensure functionality and communication during times of disaster. We were also able to relay the concerns I heard from you after Hurricane Irma and further grow the dialogue to work efficiently and effectively together. In addition, we are coordinating closely with Seminole County and other municipalities on the subject of hurricane preparedness to plan and share resources.

While we work to ensure preparedness, I urge residents to do so as well. In addition to your tangible resources (e.g. generators or battery-operated electronics), use your community resources such as Seminole County's "Prepare Seminole" program to register for hurricane seminars and to utilize the "Make a Plan" checklist. To guarantee transparent communication, I encourage everyone to visit the City's website and sign up for the Nixle e-alerts system to receive emergency alerts or follow the City of Winter Springs Facebook page where updates along with news and events are posted regularly. The safety and readiness of you and your family is my top priority.

HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS PLANNING AND TIPS

Hurricane season begins this month. If you have not prepared already, now would be the time to start. With the help of floridadisaster.org/planprepare, we have put together some tips to help you and your family prepare effectively for hurricane season.

WHEN PLANNING:

- **Family Plan:** Make a plan today. In the case that your family is separated when a hurricane hits, it is important to know how you will contact each other and reconnect.
- **Disaster Supply Kit:** Build a disaster supply kit. This kit should have supplies that will get you through a few days, while power and critical infrastructure is reestablished.
- **Place to Go:** If you choose or are ordered to evacuate, preplan where you will be going.
 - Seminole County will open shelters throughout the area to accommodate anyone who needs to evacuate.
 - Please note that not all shelters will accommodate pets. Create a Pet Disaster Plan for your household animals or livestock.
 - If traveling to a hotel, be sure to make reservations before you leave and pick a location with the understanding of where the storm may go.

BEFORE A HURRICANE:

- If you choose to shelter-in-place, select a small interior room with no or few windows.
 - Close and lock all windows and exterior doors.
 - Turn off all heating and air conditioning systems.
 - Close the fireplace damper.
 - Get your family disaster kit.
 - Go to an interior room without windows that is above ground level.
 - Have a hard wired telephone in the room you select. Call your emergency contact and have the telephone available if you need to report a life-threatening condition.
 - Continue to listen to your radio or television until you are told all is safe.
