



SAFETY REMINDERS



The Winter Springs Police want you to travel safe, enjoy the Thanksgiving holiday with your family and friends, and be safe and smart during the hustling and bustling on Black Friday. Listed below are some quick tips to keep you and your family safe while shopping for deals:

- 1. Make a plan: Plan and map out which stores you plan to visit and items you plan to purchase; this will help you get organized and avoid chaos and confusion in a large crowd.
- 2. Leave the kids at home: Leave your children with a babysitter, grandparents, or your spouse. If you need a shopping partner, call a friend instead. Marathon shopping in large crowds puts children at the risk of getting hurt, lost, or kidnapped.
- **3. Drive carefully:** Park in well-lit spaces and be sure to lock the car, close the windows, and hide shopping bags in the trunk.
- **4. Secure your cash:** Stay alert and be aware of what's going on around you. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash and pay with a debit or credit card wherever possible. Deter pickpockets and purse-snatchers by wearing belly bags or a cross-body bag with a zipper.
