

ADA Transition Plan

Summary

Per the requirements of 28 CFR 35.105 and 150(d), requiring all government agencies with fifty or more employees, the City of Winter Springs (City) will implement an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan.

This plan encompasses City facilities, sidewalks and other pedestrian features not excepted. The City has approximately 200 miles of public sidewalks within its jurisdictional limits. Sidewalks located within the City's Rights-of-Way are inspected for ADA compliance as part of asset inspections for other City infrastructure related items within the project area. Sidewalk inspections include; sidewalks, curb ramps, crosswalks, and major driveway or access location crossings. Deficiencies are identified and prioritized based on a schedule that relates to other infrastructure related improvements in the specified area. The City utilizes Geographic Information Systems tools to assist in inventorying and locating sidewalk locations. City Staff follows guidelines as set forth by the Florida Department of Transportation's Design Standards. The City annually budgets approximately \$185,000 for said sidewalk and crosswalk renovations and repairs within the City's ROW.
