
The City assures every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, including programs and activities that do not receive federal financial aid.

In the event that the City distributes federal aid funds to another entity, the City will include Title VI language in all written agreements and will monitor for compliance.

The City's Public Works and Utilities Coordinator, Rebecca McKeown, is delegated the authority to develop, maintain, implement and monitor this policy as required by federal law and regulations.
